



Q35 - How many roommates do you currently have?







Q9 - If you have more than one roommate, think about the one you've lived with the longest. How long did you know him/her prior to living together?








Q16 - What bills do you share monthly? Check all that apply.







Q25 - What tools do you use to track your bills? Check all that apply. Please enter applications you use in "other".







Q28 - How useful do you think an automated report of all your monthly bills would be for you?




